The process

Stage 1 - Initial advice request - complete
Stage 2 - Initial key stakeholder engagement - underway
Stage 3 - Technical report completion - underway
Stage 4 - Seek endorsement to lodge a Ministerial Infrastructure Designation - November 2025
Stage 5 - Lodge MID - November 2025
Stage 6 - Ministerial consultation period - 6 weeks
Stage 7 - Project consultation period concurrent with above - 6 weeks
Stage 8 - Minister reviews submissions
Stage 9 - Minister assesses and decides
Stage 10 - Construction
Stage 11 - Operation

Ministerial Infrastructure Designation

A ministerial infrastructure designation (or MID) is a process for delivering certain types of infrastructure. The MID process provides an alternative to lodging a development application with local government. The process is managed by the Department of State Development, Infrastructure and Planning with input from other Government agencies. The Planning Minister is responsible for making decisions on MIDs.
